



Contest "Call for Abstracts" organized pursuant to art. 6 DPR 430/2001 paragraph 1, letter a) - Competitions organized for the production of scientific works

The "La Venaria Reale" Conservation and Restoration Center Foundation (hereinafter also the "Promoting Company") with registered office in via XX Settembre 18, 10078 Venaria Reale (TO), Partita IVA (VAT number) 09120370011, Codice Fiscale (Tax Code) 97662370010, R.E.A. TO-1035302, on the occasion of the Young Professionals Forum 2020 (hereinafter also "Forum") and in order to promote the development of innovative solutions with regard to the protection of cultural heritage, announces the *Call for Abstract* competition, as described below.

PERIOD OF DEVELOPMENT

- Deadline for submission of abstracts: 10 June 2020
- Deadline for communication of the selected abstracts: 20 June 2020
- Voting of the most appreciated abstracts by the public registered at the Forum: from 25 June to 30 June

TERRITORY

Abstracts can be sent by candidates without nationality limits.

The evaluation of the abstracts by the jury will take place by means of telematic comparison between the members of the Scientific Committee of the Forum.

RECIPIENTS

The competition is aimed at students close to graduation or recent graduates, doctors involved in the process of obtaining a doctoral degree, young researchers and professionals working in the field of cultural heritage conservation.

PRIZES

For each of the 4 sessions of the *Forum*, the sum of € 1,000 will be assigned to the work proclaimed winner by the Scientific Committee.

The sum will be delivered by bank money transfer to the personal data indicated by the winners with communication subsequent to the declaration of winning.

OPERATING MODES

To participate in the contest, you must register for the Forum by filling in the appropriate application form, accessible at the web address <https://www.centrorestaurovenaria.it/ricerca-innovazione/young-professionals-forum/registration>.

Upon registration, the candidate will be asked to send his abstract (in English, of a maximum of 700 words and containing no more than 4 images - 220 dpi max) concerning to a maximum of 2 sessions with respect to which the candidate intends to present the work. However, it won't be possible to be nominated winners in more than one session.

Each candidate may submit only one abstract. Each candidate may appear as author or co-author of only one abstract. In the case of work realized by several authors, the winnings will be equally distributed among them.

The relevant work must illustrate case studies, research projects in the humanities/technical/scientific field or conservation/fruition programs in which the candidate has played a prominent role. The work must present original material and never have been published before.

By sending the abstract, the candidate guarantees to be the holder of the intellectual property rights on the work presented and/or to have previously obtained the necessary consents and permits from any other persons involved, thus relieving the Promoting Company of any possible dispute by third parties.

During the application procedure, a video presentation of the candidate and at least one letter of reference from a professor/researcher/professional who has supported/promoted or contributed to the work will also be requested. Also this material, like the reference abstract, must also be in English. By submitting the abstract, the candidate consents to the disclosure of the same for the purpose of its assessment and / or vote in the context of the Young Professionals Forum 2020.

In case of victory, you also agree to the publication of the related article within the Forum.

Selection criteria

The winners will be selected by the Scientific Committee of the Forum (hereinafter also the "Committee"), made up of 7 members, identified as follows:

- Michela Cardinali - CCR, Director of Conservation Laboratories and Head of the Higher Education and Study School.

- Costanza Miliani - CNR, Consiglio Nazionale delle Ricerche italiano, Director

The Committee will evaluate the projects through unquestionable judgment, based on the quality of the contents, their originality, the effectiveness of the presentation and communication methods. Specifically, abstracts will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

- Originality and innovative capacity of the work presented
- Applicability of the proposed solutions to the conservation of cultural heritage activities
- Technical validity
- Solidity of the logical-argumentative structure and clarity of exposition
- Multidisciplinary approach
- Preferences expressed by the public registered in the Forum during a specific vote

In the case of projects evaluated with the same score, the admission priority will be determined by the Scientific Committee.

Reception of the material and anonymity towards the jury

The abstracts and the relative registration forms will be numbered progressively in order of registration for the competition, then separating the first ones from the second, in order to guarantee



the anonymity of the participants at the time of the evaluation of their projects by the Scientific Committee.

The abstracts only will then be sent by e-mail to the members of the Scientific Committee, who will discuss electronically about the assessments in one or more dedicated sessions.

Proclamation of the win and prizes delivery

The winners will be announced at the end of the Forum session for which their abstract will be the winner.

The win will be confirmed by e-mail communication sent to the e-mail address communicated during the application.

Within 10 days of receiving the confirmation email, the winner must communicate, always by email to be sent to the youproforum@centrorestaurovenaria.it the bank personal data on which to pay the winnings, attaching a copy of a valid identity document and your telephone number.

In-depth article of the abstract

At the end of the event, the winning authors will be asked to send an article that will be published during the Young Professionals Forum 2020 .

The editorial guidelines and specific information relating to the presentation of the article will be communicated to the winners at a time after their selection.

COMPENSATION FOR WITHHOLDING TAX

The Promoting Company undertakes to pay the withholding tax referred to in Article 30 of Presidential Decree 600/1973 due on the prizes paid to the winners equal to 25% of the value of the prizes, also renouncing the right to recourse of the withholding tax itself.

PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

The Promoting Company, as Data Controller pursuant to art. 13 of the Privacy Law, undertakes to use and keep the information communicated by the candidates for the sole purposes related to the Young Professionals Forum 2020 event and in full compliance with the current data protection regulations.
